

**Important before handling the disposal process:**

Evaluation of defective batteries according to SV 376 ADR by BAM. If the battery is in an "undefined condition", collection is not possible (ADR regulation).

**Instructions for disposal via BMZ:**

1. Description of the battery (chemical composition)  
Specifies whether the battery is from BMZ or another manufacturer  
Attach picture material to the battery
2. Complete the BAM assessment and send it to the Central Service.  
→ If properly assessed, the battery will be picked up.
3. Battery must be packed in dangerous goods packaging
4. Costs for BMZ batteries:  
Hazardous goods packaging free of charge  
Transport costs within Germany € 30, -  
Disposal fee € 5, -/kg
5. Costs for rechargeable batteries from other manufacturers:  
Hazardous goods packaging € 15, -  
Transport costs within Germany € 60, -  
Disposal fee € 10, -/kg
